

R&DMRC Members Items for Sale – Terms and Conditions

1. R&DMRC will provide space and assistance at its Exhibitions to enable members to sell their surplus railway or other modelling equipment. 10% of the amount each item is sold for is automatically donated to R&DMRC. For non-members sales, the rate is 15%
2. R&DMRC reserve the right to withdraw any unsuitable or unsafe items from sale.
3. Members should use their initials as an identifier on both item labels and forms, using 3 letters such as JAA. Should more than 30 items be included, a second form should be used for items 31 upwards and the numbers incremented from 31 to 60, then 61 to 90 etc.
4. Individual members are responsible for the pricing and correct labelling of their stock. R&DMRC takes no responsibility for incorrectly priced or mis-labelled items. Unlabelled or unpriced items will not be accepted for sale. The R&DMRC reps will NOT price or label items on behalf of members.
5. Items should be labelled separately except where a set comprises 2 or more parts to make the whole (e.g. a 3-car DMU would have labels on each individual car showing item no plus "1 of 3", "2 of 3", etc) If possible, the parts of the set should be physically connected (rubber bands, etc)
6. Items should be fit for purpose (or clearly described/labelled otherwise if not). Items should be described as accurately as possible, especially if damaged or non-working. Mains operated items must be fitted with the appropriate fused plug and be in proper working order.
7. On arrival, members stock will be checked in against the completed form and must be signed in. Items listed for sale but missing will be deleted from the list and not counted.
8. Any unsold items must be collected by the seller at the end of the show and signed out. Uncollected items will be disposed of by R&DMRC and any monies resulting there from will be wholly donated to R&DMRC.
9. Members should carefully check their unsold items against the list before signing unsold stock out. R&DMRC take no responsibility for items unsold but not returned once the member has signed out.
10. Items are sold on the basis that the agreed percentage (item 1) of the 'Sold For' price is donated to R&DMRC – this will be calculated and deducted by R&DMRC.
11. Sellers should indicate the Asking Price and, if appropriate, a Reserve Price for each item on the form(s) and clearly show the Asking Price on the label attached to each item. The R&DMRC rep will attempt to obtain the best price for each item within the range shown on the form. If no reserve is shown, then offers below the Asking Price will not be accepted.
